



## EDUCATION RULES

Our aim within the education department is to give pupils/ students a worthwhile and enjoyable educational experience. We would ask teachers and assisting adults to read the rules set out below, in conjunction with the **park rules**, to ensure everyone has a safe and fun time.

- Throughout the visit to the park teachers remain in loco parentis, and are responsible for the general health and safety of their pupils/ students. Supervision should be as follows:
  - Foundation - 1 teacher/assisting adult to 4 pupils
  - Key Stage 1 - 1 teacher/assisting adult to 5 pupils
  - Key Stage 2 - 1 teacher/assisting adult to 6 pupils
  - Key Stage 3 and above - 1 teacher/assisting adult to 10 pupils/students
- Pupils/students should be made aware of the rules before coming to the park.
- No smoking is permitted inside any of the buildings, in ride queues or on rides. However, we would ask teachers to make students aware that this is a family theme park and ask students to exercise restraint.
- Before coming to the park we would ask teachers to brief and prepare pupils/students about the purpose of their visit.
- For our education led groups, workbooks, activity sheets and other resources will be provided. However, pupils/students will need to bring their own pens, pencils and clipboards.
- We ask that pupils/students are reminded to be courteous, well behaved and respect the members of the public using the park.
- As many of the pupils/students will be carrying out activities within the park teachers are asked to ensure that pupils/students wear suitable clothing and footwear.
- Please ask pupils/students to place litter in the bins provided.
- Pupils/students should not feed or tease the animals, nor throw objects into the animal enclosures.
- Pupils/students must not use equipment/rides designed for use outside their age group.
